- prepare the financial statements in the going concern basis unless it is inappropriate to presume that the company will continue business.

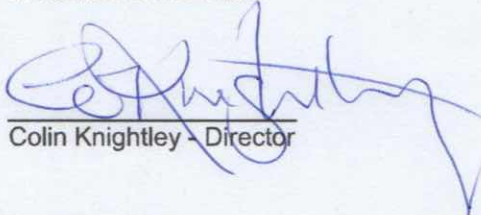

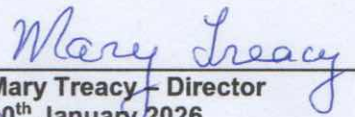
We, as directors of Dream Doors Ltd., state that:
