#### **Directors Report**

##### **Principal activities**

The principal activity of the Company is to support children and young adults with speech and language communication needs, by focusing on four main pillars – advocacy and awareness, research, family support and fundraising, in line with the memorandum of association.

##### **Results**

The surplus for the year, amounted to €2,025 (2024: €17,924).

##### **Review of the year**

Since incorporation in 2021, Finding Charlie's Voice has focused on the main pillars noting amongst other items the following successes:

**Advocacy** – Advocated publicly and privately for awareness and support of speech and language communication needs within disability and primary care services and within the educational setting by meeting with both the Minister for State with Responsibility for Special Education and the Minister for State with Responsibility for Disability. Invited attendee at the Inclusion Ireland AAC Conference. Panel member at the European Autism Summit and guest lecturer with Coláiste Dhulaigh and RCSI.

**Awareness** – We were shortlisted for the Charity Impact Awards 2021 and winner of one of the My Kids Time Charity of the Year Awards 2022. We ran our first in person conference in February 2024, moderated by David Gillick with guest speakers such as Dublin's Lord Mayor, CEO of AsIAM, CEO Inclusion Ireland and many more. Our second conference ran in September 2025 with 200 attendees. We want to thank those who attended and those who supported our 'Your Voice Matters' event and look forward to being able to run another event in 2026. We were awarded the privilege of GAA Official Charity Partner for 2025. We worked with a production company to develop a video highlighting the importance of the many ways that we communicate. We shared this with 65,000 people at the All-Ireland Semi Final Football Match on July 12<sup>th</sup>. To date, our video has been viewed on our own social media platform over 100,000 times. We were interviewed pitch side in Croke Park and shared our story and the importance of accepting and validating the many ways we communicate.

**Research** – Collaborated with University of Limerick, providing the subjects and inspiration necessary for the first research piece on Verbal Dyspraxia in Ireland, titled 'Experiences of the impact of DVD/CAS and service provision for children with DVD/CAS in Ireland from SLTs, Parents and young people with DVD/CAS'. This was presented at the annual conference of Irish Association of Speech and Language Therapists in September 2021. Collaborated with NUIG in 2024, as part of a pilot in school lesson plan to teach about the different ways we communicate.

**Support** – Developed Communication Boards to provide communication opportunity for those that may need it to include St Patrick's Day & Sensoria Festivals, our GAA and IRFU community in 2023/2024. To date we have reached 500,000 children and have covered all 32 counties in terms of placement, We are delighted to have also worked with Dublin City Council, Tipperary, Louth and Leitrim County Councils in 2024 and Dublin City Libraries to develop location specific communication boards for all. We continue to visit schools and offer information and support to teachers, snas's, parents and visit and present to third level students undertaking speech and language courses as the voice of a parent with lived experience and to share the work we do at Finding Charlie's Voice.






